FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can I have a pistol in the car while picking up kids at school?

If you have a permit, yes. The "Gun Free School Zone Act" exempts permit holders as long as your permit is issued in the state where you are in the school zone.

Can I carry in a vehicle without a permit?

Yes, however your pistol must be unloaded and in a place where you, nor anyone else in the vehicle, can reach it. There is no restriction on any legal long gun, and they may be kept loaded.

Where am I not allowed to carry a weapon?

Federal facilities (except Federal parks), a court house/annex, police stations, sheriff's office, district attorneys office, and a few more. See bamacarry.org for the entire code reference.

What is the legal age to carry?

The legal age is 19 in Alabama for both open and concealed carry.

Can I consume alcohol when armed?

There is no law concerning alcohol and carrying a pistol. However, having a few drinks before a self-defense shooting, prosecutors may use it against you at YOUR trial. It is a bad idea and never advised.

Can I carry in to a business such as Lowe's, Wal-Mart, or a convenience store?

Large businesses like Lowe's and Wal-Mart typically follow state law, so open or concealed carry is normally allowed. For any business that has no gun signage, signs do not carry the weight of law in AL. You could be asked to leave the premises however, and then could face trespassing charges if you don't comply.

Do I have to give the serial number of my gun when I apply for a permit?

NO! This is a form of registration and it's illegal for you to be asked.

OPEN vs CONCEALED CARRY

BamaCarry takes no stance on pushing one form of carry over the other. Both are perfectly legal. It was during Alabama's civil rights era that lawmakers made CONCEALING a firearm illegal without first being permitted to do so. Open carry has been legal since before the formation of the state.

Both forms of carry have their place in society. There are opinions to support the effectiveness and downfalls of both carry methods. However, Bamacarry stands up for and defends all legal ways of carry.

CONCEALED HANDGUN PERMITS

Before 2014, sheriffs of this state could deny permits for any reason whatsoever. Some abused this power by politically holding permits hostage from people who simply disagreed with them or "voted for the other guy".

In late 2013, new laws went in effect that limited the criteria for a sheriff to use in order to deny a permit. This was a big step in reversal of a law that has served to oppress, discriminate, and intimidate the people of Alabama into political submission by some sheriffs.
